Date: August 2, 2007

On July 24, 2007, the Board approved Notation Item 566A, thereby adopting the Case Study and Recommendation on the incident at the Synthron facility in Morganton, North Carolina on January 31, 2006. The approval of Notation Item 566A was preceded by Notation Item 566. Notation Item 566 was originally submitted for adoption by the Board on July 11, 2007. It was disapproved on July 20, 2007, so that a revised draft case study and recommendation, incorporating revisions requested by Board Members, could be circulated. That led to Notation Item 566A and the version of the Case Study and Recommendation adopted by the Board. Voting summaries are in reverse order, as the final version, Notation Item 566A, resulted in adoption of the Synthron Case Study.
