You are invited to attend this public meeting focusing on the US Chemical Safety Board's (CSB) investigation of the incident at the ExxonMobil refinery in Torrance in February 2015. At the meeting, the Board and public will hear from agency staff about preliminary findings and future investigation plans. There will be time for public comments. The Board and public will also discuss with a panel of experts California's draft oil refinery safety reforms.

During the February 2015 incident, two workers were injured after a hydrocarbon explosion in a pollution control process.
