

Serve as agency attorney for the Chemical Safety and Hazard Investigation Board (CSB). Provide legal advice to Members and staff in support of the agency's mission. Responsible for conducting legal research and drafting legal memoranda and briefs in a variety of legal practice areas. This includes administrative law, employment and EEO law, legislation, fiscal law and appropriations, government contracts, statutory interpretation and other general law matters. Other practice areas include the Privacy Act program.

Represent the Agency in administrative proceedings (e.g., MSPB, EEOC) and in judicial proceedings in Federal court, as appropriate. Participates in interagency committees, working groups, and task forces dealing with legal issues.

Special consideration will be given to applicants with the following qualifications:

1. Demonstrated competency in the rulemaking process;
2. Federal employment law, especially experience representing parties before the MSPB and EEOC
3. Federal litigation experience.

Applicants must possess a professional law degree (LL.B. or J.D.) from an ABA-accredited school and have admission to the Bar.

Bar Membership: An applicant must be a member in good standing (as defined by the pertinent Bar) of a State, Territory of the United States, the District of Columbia, or the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and be admitted to practice before a state or federal court.
