**Board Directive #17**

1. Whereas, the Board voted on November 5, 1999, to direct the Chairman to retract his letter of October 29, 1999, to the Administration and to the Congress, which purported to be the authorized Chemical Safety Board's FY 2001 budget request and,
2. whereas the Chairman has refused to retract his October 29, 1999, budget request and,
3. whereas the Board and the Chairman have met and resolved their differences on the proposed budget and have produced a proposed FY 2001 budget in the amount of \$9 million.

Therefore the Board directs the Chairman, by December 17, 1999, to write to the Administration and to the Congress and substitute the \$9 million figure for the Chairman's earlier, non-Board-authorized figure, and to provide written confirmation to the Board Members that he has done so.
