Arkema Inc. Chemical Plant Fire



- Aug. 29, 2017
- Hurricane Harvey Cat 4
- Rainfall exceeded design elevations
- Loss of power/decomp/fire
- 200 residents evac/week

CSB Rec No. 2017-08-I-TX-R1 (R1) to Arkema Crosby:

Reduce flood risk to as low as reasonably practicable (ALARP). Ensure that any safeguards for flooding meet independent layer of protection requirements.

Arkema Crosby implementation of R1:




- Completed a site elevation survey and hydrology study.
- Undergone a PHA using a layersof-protection approach.
- Received multiple updated Harris County building permits including flood elevation standard (55.5 ft above mean sea level)

Pressure Vessel Explosion at Loy-Lange Box Company



- April 3, 2017
- Pressure vessel ruptured/ propelled
- Inadequate repair
- 4 fatalities (1 worker/ 3 members of the public)


CSB Rec No. 2017-04-I-MO-R7 (R7) to Arise, Inc.:

Include prescriptive elements in the boiler and pressure vessel repair and alteration inspection and acceptance process that would prevent the acceptance of a non-conforming repair or alteration.

Arise, Inc. implementation of R7:



- Updated Quality Processes
- Included additional inspection points to verify repair compliance
- Annual audit by supervisor to verify utilization of new inspection points in addition to other criteria.
