1. The U.S. Chemical Safety and Hazard Investigation Board has developed its first Strategic Plan in accordance with the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) of 1993 (see attachment);
2. The Strategic Plan sets the vision and direction for the CSB for the next five years (FY2001-FY2005);
3. The Strategic Plan will be used by the CSB as a guide in setting priorities, allocating resources, and making decisions that produce the specific outcomes identified in the plan;
4. The Strategic Plan is due to Congress by September 29, 2000; and
